LICENSURE

If you are vending food you will need to comply with State of Michigan Food Safety Laws. When we receive your application we will forward your name to the Western Upper Peninsula Health Department (WUPHD) and they will contact you. Please see <http://www.wuphd.org/environmental-health/food-protection-program/food-service-licensing/> .

BAKE-OFF COMPETITION

This year's bake-off event is for *commercial participants only*. We ask each vendor provide 100, ~4 oz. pasties (should be about 4 bites each). Main Street Calumet will then discreetly label each pasty (using colored toothpicks) and sell one small pasty from each vendor in a kit/box. Attendees will then purchase a box, taste all pasties and pick their favorite, voting by returning the toothpick to the Main Street booth. This will encourage the public to test your pasty alongside your competitors'. We will tally votes and announce the winner once we feel all votes are in. The winner gets to keep the Pasty Fest trophy for the year and of course serious bragging rights!

Please drop-off pasties by 10:30am at Main Street booth, located near other pasty vendors in the intersection of Oak & 5th Streets. Pasties should NOT be pre-packaged, if you deliver on pans, please label them so we can return them to you after the event.

VENDOR SPACES

Pasty Vendors will be set up in the parking lot next to the Keweenaw National Park Visitors Center, off Scott Street between 4th and 5th. We will have access to some 10x10 tents, and can provide each vendor with 2, 6' tables and 2 chairs per space. We will set up a hand wash station in proximity to the food vendors and there are porta-potties available as well.

ELECTRICAL ACCESS

We will be providing electrical access for pasty vendors. It is however somewhat LIMITED. We have 1 – 15amp outlet for each vendor. You can bring your own generator and are responsible

for providing all necessary accessories including power strips, heavy-duty extension cords and cable ramps (or rugs) to prevent trip hazards.

WEATHER

This is a rain or shine event, please come prepared! This means tablecloth clips, heavy items to contain napkins/light weight things, etc.

SET UP AND TEAR DOWN

Set up for vendors begins at 10:00am and must be complete by 11:30am. 5th Street will be closed between Wedge Street and Pine Street for the event, with Elm kept open for cross traffic. Vendors have permission to bypass barricades for set up but vehicles MUST be off 5th street by end of set up time at 11:30 am. Please be considerate of other vendors, unpack gear and move your vehicle ASAP.

Best access to the Pasty Vendor site is via 4th Street as 5th is closed for the event as are the cross streets. Please see layout map for recommended entry.

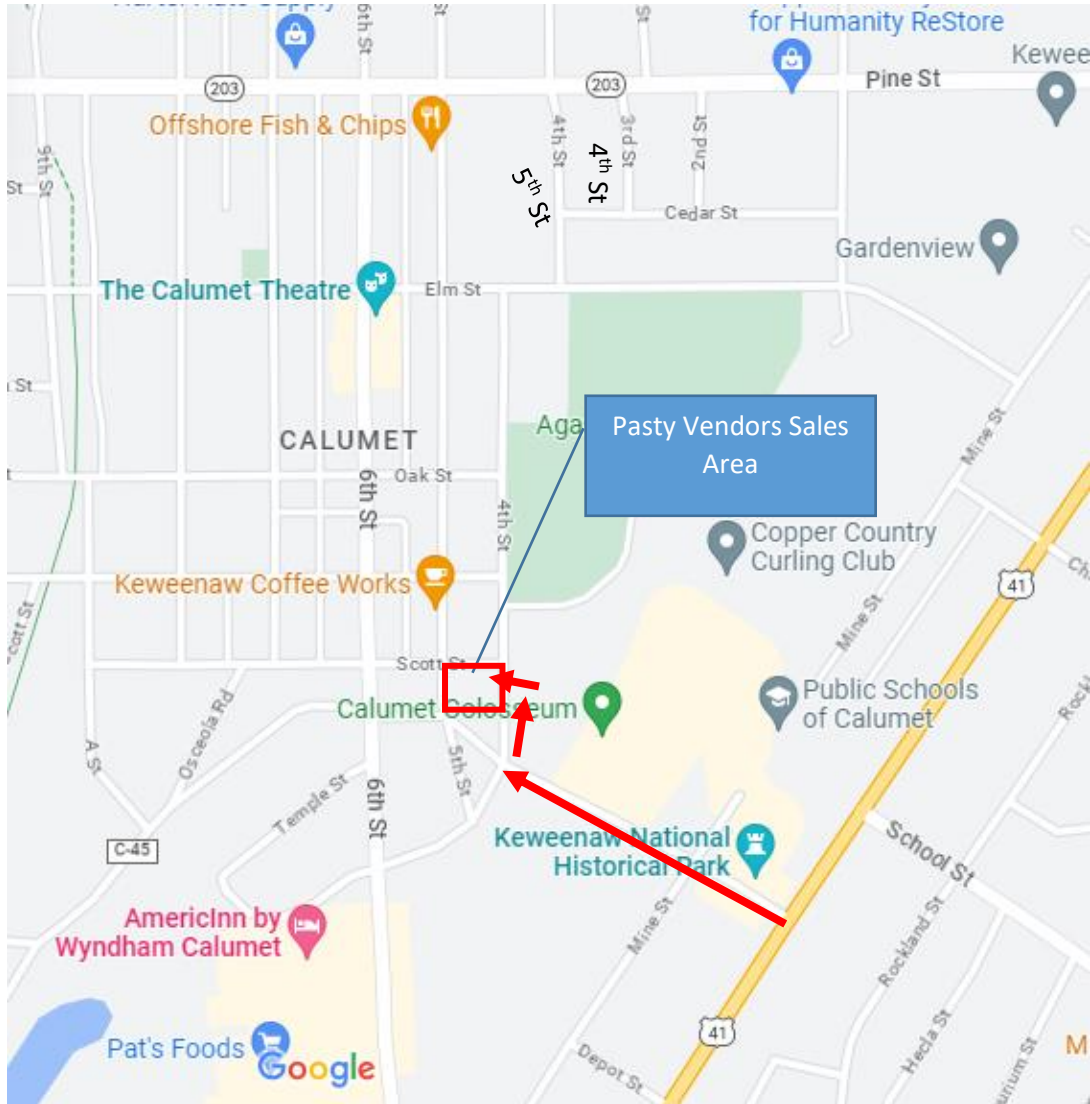

We recommend entry to the area via 4th Street. The easiest way to reach 4th is to turn onto Red Jacket Road (which does become 5th Street – which will be closed for the event at Wedge St) and then onto 4th Street just past the Calumet Colosseum (indoor ice rink). The Pasty Vendor sales area is located in the parking lot of the Keweenaw National Historical Park Visitors Center (red square outline above).
